## Postal Service to Host Public Notification Meeting on Proposed Relocation of the Drake Post Office

**What:** The U.S. Postal Service is hosting a public notification meeting regarding the Drake Post Office that is located at 1601 US HWY 34, Drake, CO 80515.

**Where:** Big Thompson Canyon Association Building

Due space deficiencies and safety concerns in the original building, the Postal Service is considering relocating the Post Office. The Postal Service is looking for either 1000 sq. ft. of an existing building or 6,000 to 10,000 square feet of ground to lease for a modular building.

The new location will be as close as reasonably possible to the current Post Office. Retail Services will continue at the Drake Temporary Main Office until the new facility is ready.
